| HOW TO DO IT?     | Steps: -Practice the sounds you want to practice with your students like 'TH' sound, -Show students your tongue twisters, -Read the tongue twisters several times to show your students how they should pronounce them, -Give them time to practice them for a bit, and then let the read it aloud, -You can record your students with a camera to show them the effect later. |  |
