
FRASMUS + Science in Our Little Hands English Language Club Presentation Turkey

- Do you have a pet?


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WHAT ARE YOU DOING? GAME

We practiced Present Continuous Tense by playing a game. We wrote down Present Continuous Tense sentences as seen below and put all these piece of papers in a box. (I am jumping, I am sleeping, I am running, etc.)

Each student selected one piece of paper and demonstrated the movements as written on the piece of paper selected

DICE GAME

We believe in that playing game is a very effective way of learning. So we play lots games in our lessons. While they are playing they enjoy and acquire the language. In this game, students made their dices, they played and made sentences by looking at the pictures on the dice. Students are able to describe what people are doing and expressing their feelings.

He is sad. etc.








MAKING A SURVEY

Students made their own surveys with their friends about their favorite activities. While they were preparing their surveys, decided to ask what they are going to ask. Examples: Do you like cooking? Do you like reading newspaper? Do you like swimming? etc.





DOING AN EXPERIMENT

Students performed an experiment in the class. We wrote related vocabulary on the board. They recognized related words while doing the experiment.





DOING AN EXPERIMENT



This experiment needs: water, food coloring, lettuce.

- 1. Pour the water in the glass
- 2. Add some food coloring
- 3. Put in the lettuce
- 4. Wait ten minutes
 Then they saw the lettuce's color changed.

Vocabulary they learned;

To cover, to cut, to mix, microscope, experiment, tube, magnifier, to pour, etc.

VOCABULARY GAME - BINGO

The teacher distributed to each group one card that contains pictures of vocabulary words in each square.

The teacher drew a random word card from a bag, and call out the vocabulary word on the card. Students search and mark the corresponding vocabulary pictures on their cards.

The game continues until a student calls out, "Bingo!" A student may call out, "Bingo!" only if that student has crossed off all the pictures.


QUIZ SHOW




